September 19th, loma Linda partnership for Veterans, anticipating 200-250 persons. Heidi Strutz, City of Colton – Approved contract with SWAG for outreach, new. Also partnering with SBCP and US Vets for Shelter Court in August. Lanea Coleman and Pastor Mark Nuami gave updates for their partnership in the City of Fontana –Pastor Nuami discussed the Water of Life project updates.		
		Councilwoman Ibarra, City of San Bernardino – designing a navigation center, will be designed in phases for permanent housing 1500 units. Assistance with hygiene and food resources can be provided through the assistant of Ibarra. Staff will be providing reports that details funding and design. A new group to be developed to assist the most vulnerable population called PEACE.
