A quorum was present—6 of 7 voting members present. ATTENDANCE: (12) The August meeting of the Mountain Regional Steering Committee and the Mountain Homeless Provider Network included representatives from various organizations working to support the homeless in the region. Dev.-Big Bear Lake), Voting Members Excused: Annamieke Stalcup (BearVly Comm. Health); Joselyn Field (Rim Fam. Serv.); Voting Members Absent: Shonda Szabo (Bear Valley USD); Secretary: Gary Bradley (MHC) Presenters: Kathy Schwab (First Baptist, Crestline); AND Jessica Ehret (Rim Family Services) Other Attendees today (7): Sue Walker (Pres., MHC), Erica Walters; Becky Beavers, Stephanie Bruce, Tyrese Crawford (Homeless Youth Education-SBCo-SS) Also: PUBLIC COMMENT **APPROVAL** --MINUTES Minutes Wendell Public Comment invited and Minutes for July 10, 2024 approved with **MOTION** by Paul Fournier and 2nd by Kelly Tinker. PASSED ACTION **ITEMS** NONE Wendell No specific decisions, action items, or open questions were raised PRESENTA-TION Work on Kathy (Kathy Schwab joined us from Mexico!) Behalf of the Schwab Homeless Support Homeless/At + Jessica Kathy shared her experience with the Mountain Help ministry of First Baptist -Risk Ehret Church, Crestline, discussing the services provided by Mountain Help. Kathy Population in shared her experiences working with U-turn for Christ, a ministry that provides the assistance to needy families and individuals, including homeless people, and the Mountains challenges she faced in getting people to show up for appointments. Gary provided Kathy with contact details and information about the Mountain

Homeless Coalition's list of area food banks. Kathy expressed concern for a person inquiring about electric heating costs and shared that an average of five people have been visiting the coalition's services. Wendell discussed Mountain Homeless Coaltion's resource guide, which Kathy confirmed receiving from Becky who

offered to drop more resources at the Baptist church for Kathy to copy and distribute. Kathy also showed interest in Operation Provider esp. regarding their utility assistance program.

Rim Family Services

Wendell introduced Jessica from Rim Family Services, an organization that promotes active and healthy lifestyles for the older adult community. Jessica shared her role in providing resources, referrals, and services for various programs, including mental health, after-school programs, home safety inspections, and social events. She requested a copy of the Food Bank resource list to assist in her work, which Gary forwarded to her. Kathy from Mountain Help expressed interest in learning more about Rim Family Services and offered to add them to their resource list. Jessica agreed to provide more information, and Kathy planned to visit Operation Provider to share information about both organizations. Jessica, Kathy, Wendell, and Becky discussed local organizations that provide assistance to those in need. Kathy shared about her church's donations to a local organization, and Wendell suggested she collaborate with the Senior Thrift Center for additional resources. Jessica offered her assistance to seniors in need, with information about the Senior Center in Crestline. The group also learned about Hope the Mission's new role in running the Victorville homeless center and their plans for a youth advocacy summit on September 7th, aimed at providing resources and support to youth experiencing homelessness or unstable housing. Becky requested Tyrese's contact information for a Spanish-speaking family in the Big Bear area who could benefit from these resources.

Wendell Wilson invited input from attendees.

Wendell invited attendees to provide information from other nonprofits, churches, and providers in the mountains to foster better relationships and understanding among them.

Tyrese shared contact details for various programs and individuals, including Bear Valley and Rim of the World, which were requested by Becky and Paul. Wendell highlighted Shonda's expertise on the McKinney-Vento program. The team also discussed the recent governance charter review and approval at the Interagency Council on Homelessness (ICH) meeting, where Paul was appointed as the Mountain Representative and joined the Grant Review Committee. Wendell and Paul presented on the California Proposition 1, a funding initiative for mental health and addiction, and its potential regional impact. The conversation ended with an open invitation for other churches or nonprofits to join their monthly Zoom meetings for improved collaboration.

- Jessica to bring updated information about Rim Family Services programs to Kathy at Mountain Help.
- Kathy to visit Operation Provider to share information about Mountain Help services.
- Tyrese to ensure resources for trans youth are available at the upcoming Youth Advocacy Summit.

- Paul to provide update on Grant Review Committee at next month's meeting.
- All attendees to provide names and contact information of other churches or nonprofits that might benefit from joining future meetings.
- Jessica to add Mountain Help to Rim Family Services' resource list.
