City of San Bernardino Homeless Services Update – Presentation –City of San Bernardino</p>	<p>Gail Maddox- Individuals that are identified as homeless in the community are put into the county system and tracked by their situation. Outreach teams can find them and enter them into the system. They do an assessment and case conference the individual. From there they identify what is the best housing situation for them to do a referral and see what agency excepts them. For Case conferencing in October 31 got Rapid Rehousing 11 Permanent Supporting Housing</p> <p>David Rabindranath- Presenter could not show but will present in January during the next meeting. Will be going dark in December.</p> <p>Maricela Manzo – Homeless Summit was pushed back to March 5th 2025. COC members are on the priority list. If not already register to be on the COC committee.
