E.	CV HHAP Round 5 - Development of CV Funding Plan for RFP – RSC members and public discussion	<p>Per the HHAP 5 Workshop presented by OHS, 3.1 million dollars were approved for funding for Central Valley. Each region is tasked in deciding which eligible use categories they want to allocate their funds in. The categories are <u>Rapid Rehousing, Prevention and Shelter Diversion, Delivery of Permanent Housing and Innovative Housing Solutions, Operating Subsidies – Permanent Housing, Street Outreach, Service Coordination and System Support.</u></p> <p>For the vote today are for these categories ONLY. Although other categories were listed in the State RFH, SB County applied only for the categories listed.</p> <p>An option proposed is a CAP of 350k for a single agency application, 500k for a collaborative of 2 or more agencies and a CAP on the Delivery of Permanent Housing and Innovation Housing Solutions.</p> <p>Most board members stated that the CAP is low, and the number should be 500k for a single agency application and 800k for 2 or more agencies. CAP was suggested to ensure that staff pay is adequate for the cost of living. After all discussion it was the consensus to fund only 5 categories that are most impactive in our region.</p> <p>A question was asked where “how established do you need to be to be able to apply for these funds” the answer to that is must have audited records that show you are reliable. A follow up question to that was “do you have to be a solo provider, or can you be an LLC” while this question was not answered this is something that would need to be further discussed.</p> <p>A motion was made by Pastor Paul Jones and 2nd by Marisela Monzo-Gomez The motion on the floor was to approve funding for 5 eligible use categories and the designated allocations as follows Rapid Rehousing 758,863k Prevention and Shelter 600k Street Outreach 600k Service Coordination 600k Delivery of Permanent Housing and Innovative Housing Solutions 600k</p> <p>The motion passed as stated above. 10 Yea’s – 0 Nay’s</p>

F. Vote on Adding/Removing Board Member and Alternates	<p>Need for a new RSC board member was necessary due to the vacancy of the Lutheran Social Services (service provider) seat. Nominations were called for, and the following nominations were made.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Loveland Church – R. Dale Evans – self nominated. 2. Children's Fund – Izamar Garcia – self nominated. 3. Antoinette Ortega – 211 United Way – self nominated. <p>The motion to call for nominations and a vote was made by Desiree Rivera and 2nd by Probation. The motion passed by the new RSC Board Member is: 211 United Way – with 15 votes. Antoinette Ortega is the designated voting member. Alternate to be named later.</p> <p>Other votes: Loveland – 13 votes Children's Fund - 2 votes</p>
