### **Reallocation of Funds**

Only one agency applied under the Delivery of Permanent Housing and Innovative Housing Solutions category, requesting \$60,000.00, leaving a remaining balance of \$540,000.00 in that category.

After careful review, evaluators recommend reallocating the remaining \$540,000.00 to the Rapid Rehousing category as part of Item H. on the April 20, 2026, Special Meeting.

If approved by the Central Valley Regional Steering Committee (Committee), the following agencies would receive additional Rapid Rehousing funds (already reflected in the totals under Recommended Awards by agency):
