From 2021 to 2022 there have been an increase of callers by over 1000 including in the homeless population and the need for housing. Top 5 Housing Resources Referred: Residential Housing, Emergency Shelter, At Risk/Homeless, Housing Expense Assistance, and Transitional Housing Shelter. ▪ Presentation: City Act Emergency Solution Grant works to help rehouse the unhoused population working with the mental health systems. ▪ Program is all inclusive helping all demographics with significant mental health barriers. ▪ Services include mental health and getting doc ready. Assistance includes identification program with DMV, and employment. ▪ Collaboration came from local agencies and individuals. ▪ Overall goal of program to help provide support to those unhoused individuals.
