Item #3. San Bernardino CoC Regional Action Plan on Homelessness	Lindsey Barranco & Ester Wilch of HomeBase agency	<p>The Chair opened Item #3, inviting the HomeBase Presenters to speak and to share the PowerPoint of the Presentation:</p> <p>-Lindsey Barranco from Homebase presented a high-level overview of the new strategic plan for San Bernardino County's Continuum of Care, focusing on the five regions and their specific</p>

action steps. The plan was developed through extensive data review, stakeholder input, and collaboration with RSC co-chairs and community members, incorporating a vision of providing safe, secure, stable affordable housing to all individuals and families across the county. The presentation covered the five main goals: permanent and affordable housing, coordination between departments and regions, improving shelter and interim housing services, prevention and diversion programs, and strengthening the homeless response system.

- Lindsey presented a high-level overview and regional snapshot
- Lindsey explained the program links and Data sources, vision and mission etc.
- Lindsey stated the 7 guiding principles.
- Discussed Action steps , goals and strategies.

-Esther emphasized that the plan should be treated as a flexible document that can evolve over time.

-Lindsey presented five action steps for the Mountain region, focusing on formal communication and collaboration, strengthening coordinated street outreach capacity, prevention and diversion pathways, building system reliance, and enhancing the coordinated entry system

-Esther encouraged the group to consider formalizing informal relationships with churches and other community organizations, suggesting this could be an opportunity to activate additional stakeholders in the homelessness response planning process.

- Wendell explains MHCs plan in response and the 5 year strategic plan.
- Paul explains MHC and how it functions and how it will respond to all info
- Zazette explains the need for a strategic action plan to be chosen , numerous ideas have been presented.

-Esther explained how the strategic plan was designed as a flexible living document due to changing funding priorities at federal and state levels.
