Evaluator's Recommendations:

There were six applications submitted for the Central Region and the top three scores were ranked as follows:

1. Water of Life
2. Step Up on Second
3. The Blessing Center

Based on the scoring and discussion, the Regional Evaluator's have recommended the following:

- Water of Life be awarded their requested budget amount of \$250,000
- Step Up on Second be awarded their requested amount of \$208,438.
- The Blessing Center be awarded the balance of \$96,559.
- The Salvation Army, Lutheran Social Services of Southern California, and Brilliant Corners were not recommended to receive grant funding for HHAP-2.
