Homeless Services/COVID-19 Updates from the Cities Represented in Central Region	Levi Deatherage/Jessica Alexander/City Representatives	<p><b><u>ICH UPDATE</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ COVID Vaccine prioritization of non-profits</li> <li>▪ HPN leaders and Karen from Light House discussed effective ways to roll out vaccinations to non-profits and homeless. Pending updates from the Office of Homeless Services regarding shelters and workers being prioritized.</li> <li>▪ <b><u>City of Fontana- Eric</u></b></li> <li>▪ Fontana shared there are 3 single family units and a 4<sup>th</sup> to come. Successful housing through support from the HOPE Team. ERAP Funds are being utilized by Fontana for eviction prevention.</li> <li>▪ <b><u>City of Rialto- Perry</u></b></li> <li>▪ Rialto reported that the funds from CARES ACT have supported small businesses and store fronts. Landlords can also apply for a small business loan if they apply for funding as a business owner.</li> <li>▪ <b><u>City of Colton - Katelyn</u></b></li> <li>▪ City of Colton stated HEAP Grant funds are continuing to be utilized and that applications are online. HAAP funding to be utilized for eviction prevention, employment searches, and housing searches.
